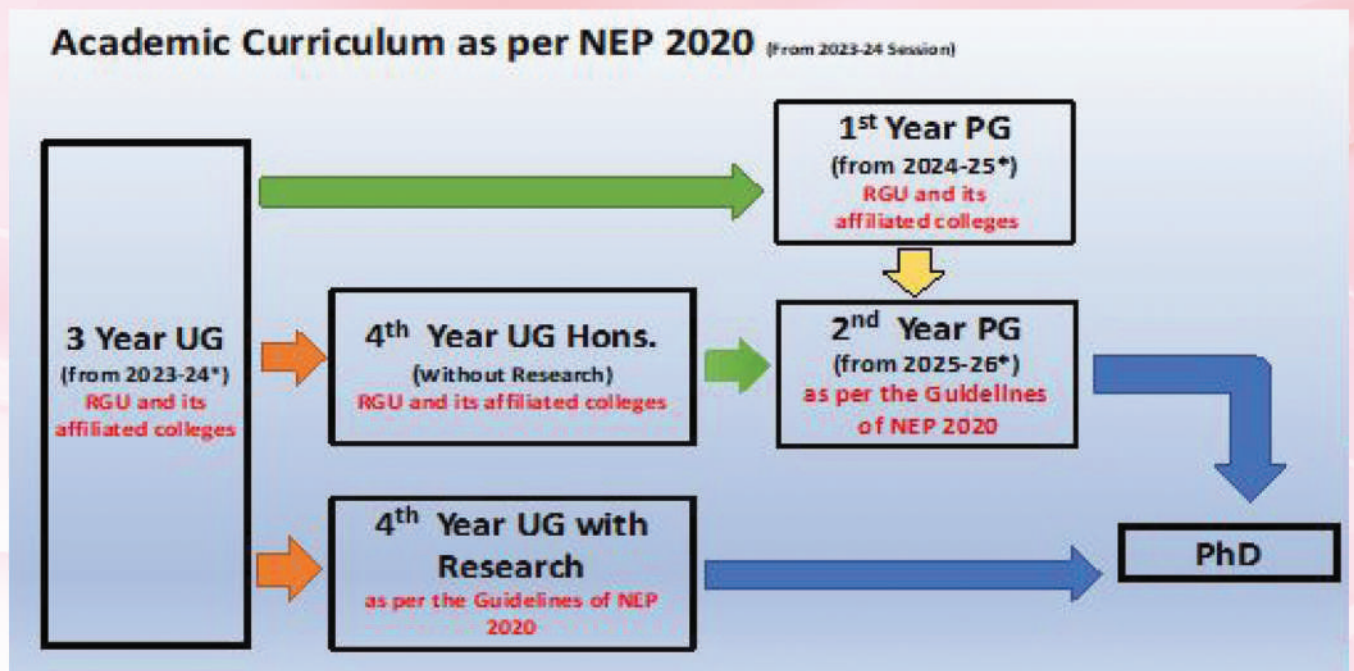
ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES OFFERED [BA & B COM]

FOUR-YEAR DEGREE PROGRAMME (FYDP)- NEP-2020

The college follows Four-Year Bachelor in Arts and Commerce Degree Programme (FYDP), as per NEP-2020. A candidate has to complete the course within a maximum period of seven years. S/he also has the option of Exiting from the study after one year (UG Certificate), two years (UG Diploma), Three years (UG Degree) or Four years (UG Degree Honours)/ UG Degree (Honours with Research).

The subjects offered are **B.A. in Education, English, Geography, History, Political Science, Sociology**
B.Com (Commerce Stream).

An academic year is divided by two semesters: An 'ODD Semester' and an 'EVEN Semester'.



ELIGIBILITY

Pass with at least 45% of marks in class XII of the CBSE or an equivalent examination recognized by RGU
Pass in Compulsory English in Class XII is a must.

1. Fill the online application form at the SAMARTH portal of Rajiv Gandhi University.
2. Submit the downloaded application form along with the following documents in the college office
 - a. Class X Mark Sheet
 - b. Class XII Mark Sheet
 - c. Passport size photo (2)
3. **Issue of admit cards for Entrance Test/Admission**
(Entrance Test is compulsory for those candidates with less than 45% marks for Class XII exam and those who have passed Class XII other than current academic year 2024 or passed through National Open School (NIOS))
4. **Admission date will be notified in the college website** (www.sfscaalo.ac.in) and notified individually through WhatsApp
5. **Admission Procedure (on the day of Admission)**
 - a. Campus Briefing
 - b. Personal Interaction
 - c. Document Verification
 - d. Meeting with Principal
 - e. Submission of Documents
 - f. Payment of Fee
6. **Documents to be brought on the day of Admission**
 - a. Class X Mark Sheet (Original with 3 Xerox copies)
 - b. Class XII Mark Sheet (Original with 3 Xerox copies)
 - c. Transfer Certificate (Original)
 - d. Academic Bank of Credit (ABC Id) copy
 - e. Aadhaar Card copy
 - f. Migration Certificate (those who has done Class XII from other state or other than CBSE)
 - g. Gap Certificate (for those have had a break in years after Class XII)

{Admission can be secured through NTA conducted CUET (UG) Examinations. (<https://exams.nta.ac.in/CUET-UG/>). } The test is usually conducted in the month of May every year.
