PILLARS OF FOCUS

1. Learner Centric Campus Atmosphere

At SFSC, the primary focus is the students. All the programs and policies are initiated and directed towards the holistic growth of the students. All the teaching learning initiatives shall be geared to enhance the quality of the learner, evaluation process and procedures shall be aimed at enabling the learner to understand one's own strengths and weakness and encourages the learner to perform better, and all the co-curricular, extracurricular and extension services shall be aimed at offering holistic growth for the learners.

2. Human Resource Enhancement

At SFSC one of the top most priorities is the human resource enhancement. Education is aimed at enhancement of human resource. To this end SFSC shall initiate programs and policies such as regular staff training program both for teaching and non teaching, orientation programs, workshop on latest teaching leaning updates in education,

3. Skill Enhancement

One of the priorities of SFSC would be to enhance the soft skills among the students. To this end SFSC shall introduce on a regular basis short term and long term certificate courses as per the need and interest of the students. It is aimed at catering to the interest of the students and make the campus atmosphere more students centric and thus make the optimal use of the time that the students spend within the campus

1. ACADEMIC EXPANSION

Concrete Steps:

- * To introduce /reinforce, in a phased manner, more subjects in BA programs like Anthropology and Education and also other courses including professional courses like B Com, BSC, BSW, BBA in a phased manner
- * To introduce internship
- * To offer certificate courses in each subject
- * To sign MoUs with various professional educational institute for mutually benefiting resources

2. INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Priority 2. SFSC commits itself to incremental and optimal development of infrastructural resources to match Priority 1 and other related priorities.

Concrete steps:

- 1. To set up a separate block for canteen, indoor games and fitness centre
- 2. To set up a separate floor exclusively for library, reading room and reference session with sufficient space to accommodate maximum number of students and staff
- 3. To set up a separate block for auditorium cum indoor stadium
- 4. To introduce CCTV to enhance the security system in the campus
- 5. To have a separate block of staff quarters
- 6. To automate office administration

3. SKILLENHANCEMENT

Priority 3. SFSC commits itself to enhance and empower the human resources both students and staff.

Concrete Steps:

- 1. To introduce more skill oriented certificate courses
- 2. To organize regular update and training programs for the teaching and non teaching staff
- 3. To organise orientation programs and issue based awareness programs
- 4. To sign MoU with various NGOs and other educational and training institute for mutually benefitting exchange programs
- 5. To organise regular career counselling programs

4. RESEARCH, PUBLICATION AND EXTENSION SERVICES

Priority 4. SFSC commits itself to focus on research, publication and extension service through its various policies and programs

Concrete Steps:

- 1. To make it mandatory for each department to organise one departmental seminar every year and to publish the proceedings of the departmental seminar in the form of departmental journal
- 2. To publish departmental news letter every year

- 3. To encourage final semester students to submit one research paper as part of the academic requirement
- 4. To encourage the staff to present research papers and increase the number of publication per staff
- 5. To organise regional, national and international seminars, conferences and workshops
- 6. To set up the centre for research and publication to publish books and journals
- 7. To organise various extension programs to enhance community service and leadership skills among students

5. EDUCATION OF THE RURAL STUDENTS

Priority 5. SFSC commits itself to provide quality education to economically backward students of Arunachal Pradesh

Concrete Steps:

- 1. To keep the college fee structure affordable so that maximum number of students can take admission
- 2. To introduce special scholarship for meritorious students and also economically backward students
- 3. To mobilize financial resources for the various infrastructure developments initiatives through the help of the sponsoring society
- 4. To have MoU signed with various charitable and education oriented Societies to help the college financially to organised various socially benefitting programs.
